AOC MADIRAN – Single vineyard

Tannat – Cabernet Sauvignon

Yield 40 hL/ha

History & Terroir

The grapes producing this wine are grown on a terroir that is geologically unique to Madiran, the *Nappe de Maucor* and constitutes a stretch of pebbles deposited by running water, found in the appellation's highest altitudes. South/south-west exposition to gain maximum sunshine on this early-ripening terroir. An oceanic, temperate climate with mild winters and hot, stormy summers.

Ageing

12 months in oak barrels of which one third are new, one third are 2nd fill and one third are 3rd fill to bestow aromatic complexity and volume.

Tasting Rich, complex, soft tannins, round tannins. Opens on the palate with intense black fruit aromas before reaching a finish of silky.

Food pairings Roast poultry, grilled red meat, duck breast.
